

Inauguration of Computer Laboratories

Tareen Education Foundation (TEF) has a mandate to improve quality of education in Pakistan. Its special focus is provision of education to marginalized communities, such as the rural poor and women, who are so often ignored from development interventions by the public sector or by international aid agencies.

Deputy Commissioner (DC) Lodhran Rao Imtiaz Ahmed on the special request of TEF inaugurated the Computer Labs in 4 Government Schools. Initially, Government Boys High School Gilaywal,



Government Boys High School Jallah Arain, Government Girls High School Jallah Arain, and Government Boys High School 362/WB have been provided with 15 CPUs, 15 LCDs, furniture, and the solar energy solution in each school. Many more labs are to be upgraded in coming months.



Inauguration of Libraries

TEF has established 27 libraries (in 23 General Schools and 4 Core Schools) equipped with vast collection of books, and started installation of multimedia projectors in them. The programme has been extended to further government schools. On April 27, 2019 – CEO District Education Authority Lodhran and Deputy Commissioner Lodhran inaugurated the library in Government Girls Higher Secondary School Jallah Arain and Government Boys High School 362-WB respectively.



Mathematics Training - Lahore School of Learning

Tareen Education Foundation facilitated the visit of 7 teachers of 3 Governments Schools of Lodhranto the Lahore School of Learning (LSL) for Mathematics training. It was conducted under the supervision of Miss Iram Qazi, and the trainer was Miss Mehwish Safdar. The training lasted for 6 hours; and the major points of the training:

- Topics of Practical Geometry, Fundamental Geometry, and Financial Arithmetic were covered
- Methods to enhance the efficiency of teaching were discussed
- Teachers participated in activity-based learning, and the model was the same as to be applied in classes for the students' engagement.
- Modern learning methods and teaching techniques were discussed to be implemented while delivering the lectures
- Lengthy discussions on the syllabus division, lesson planning, and teachers' resources management were also the part of training.


