International Kangaroo Mathematics Contest (IKMC) 2019

Tareen Education Foundation (TEF) organized the International Kangaroo Mathematics Contest (IKMC) 2019 for the second time in the remote district of Lodhran, located in the South Punjab.





This is the second time when 355 students from the 28 schools got a chance to participate in the IKMC, held in Amina Girls Higher Secondary School, 21 MPR Lodhran. This event was organized for the first time in 2018 when the 188 students from 19 schools participated in IKMC, performed extraordinarily.

In 2018, 188 students from the 19 schools participated in this event. The results were outstanding when 3 students were awarded with medals – 1 silver medal, and 2 bronze medals. Also, 8 Students earned 2** BADGES, and 59 students earned 1* BADGES.



TEF is hopeful that students would bring much success from this participation, which would be zenith ofthis hard work. In any case, this struggle would be enhanced to ensure that more students are beinggiven a chance to be part of this in coming years.



Computer Labs Upgradation
