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

Inauguration of Computer Laboratory and Library

Tareen Education Foundation (TEF) has a mandate to improve quality of education in rural areas of Pakistan. Its special focus is provision of education to marginalized communities, such as the rural poor and women, who are so often ignored from development interventions by the public sector or by international aid agencies.







District Police Officer Lodhran Malik Jameel Zafar on May 6th, 2019 inaugurated the Computer Laboratory and Library of Government Boys High School Mundhali. The former has been provided by TEF with 15 CPUs, 15 LCDs, 4 KW UPS with two 160A liquid batteries, and minor civil work.

While the later, is equipped with modern facilities which include furniture (chairs, tables, and bookshelves), books, sound system and multimedia projector.



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Takhti Online Visits Tareen Education Foundation

Adeel Imtiaz, creator of Takhti Online an Urdu-language educational science channel dedicated to develop better thinkers of Science & Technology and improve Science literacy in Pakistan – visited Tareen Education Foundation (TEF), Lodhran.





The visit comprised of two-days – 26th & 27th April, 2019 – and concluded with 7 lectures in 5 government schools. This opportunity provided 600 students a chance to get benefited from these lectures.

Elite Trainers Conduct Physics Training in Lodhran

Tareen Education Foundation hosted 2 trainers – Javed Sulehri and Mr. Ayub – from an elite school of Lahore on May 2nd, 2019 to conduct practical-based training of Physics teacher. The training was held in Amina Girls Higher Secondary School (AGHSS), attended by 25 teachers from 14 government schools and Mobile Science Center (MSC), TEF.

The prime facet of the training was experimental approach in delivering lectures to enhance the attention and interest of pupils in the lectures. One of the major objectives to hold this training is to promote the modern way of teaching science through experimentation.







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BNU Conducts Arts Training in Lodhran

Beaconhouse National University team, comprising of three members, visited Lodhran to conduct Arts training of the teachers of Lodhran Public School, Government Schools, and Tareen Education Foundation (TEF). The trainings were conducted in Lodhran Public School (LPS) and Amina Girls Higher Secondary School Lodhran (AGHSS), and 41 teachers from 12 government and 4 TEF Core schools were involved in it.

It was a comprehensive training covering following areas: creative curriculum in primary section; promotion of STEAM - Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics - education; effective strategies to enhance the efficiency of lectures. The training was concluded with one-on-one discussion among teachers and trainers.











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Awards Distribution Ceremony – IKMC

Tareen Education Foundation, on May 27, 2019, organized the Awards Distribution Ceremony of prestigious International Kangaroo Mathematics Contest (IKMC) in Ghallu Hall, Lodhran.







Deputy Commissioner Lodhran, CEO Education, and 71 headmasters attended the ceremony. The students won 1 silver medal, 5 bronze medal, 9 2* Badges, and 40 1* Badges, in addition to 1 Gold and 1 Silver Medal won by GGHS Lodhran and TEF team Mobile Science Center respectively. The honorable Chief Guest DC Lodhran Rao Imtiaz Ahmad distributed prizes – medals, certificates, badges – among the students, and cherished the hard work and dedication of TEF and its teams, students, and schools administration.
