As a part of Breast Cancer Awareness Campaign, a session for about 400 students was held in Government Girls Degree College Lodhran on 11th October, 2019.

2nd Mathematics Workshop

Tareen Education Foundation believes in the continuous capacity building and professional development of teachers. It organized the 2nd Mathematics Workshop of ESTs teaching mathematics in government schools. TEF - in collaboration with Developments in Literacy (DIL) – held the training from 23rd to 25th Oct 2019. It was 3-day training where 32 teachers from 27 government and 5 core schools received training from master trainer Mrs. Munazza Imran from DIL.



The content of the training included:

- Practical geometry and its application
- Model-based activities to ensure conceptual learning
- Model-designing activities to improve learning outcomes
- Lecture using math manipulatives and teaching resources

The 1st Mathematics Workshop was held in August, 2019. The responses from the trainees were encouraging, and they maintained that training would help in raising the learning among the students. To conclude, this training would surely help the teachers increase the efficiency of their teaching methods, and the learning among students.



4th Inter-School Throwball Tournament 2019
